**Robert Simola demo**, July 14, 7-9 pm, Wood block printing, Atascadero Gospel Chapel, Curbaril & Atascadero Ave(s)



On **Monday evening, July 14<sup>th</sup>**, at **7pm**, Robert Simola will be presenting a free demonstration at Atascadero Gospel Church at the corner of Atascadero Ave and Curburil. This is open to the community and sponsored by the Atascadero Art Association. Robert will be demonstrating wood block printing.

Robert moved up here from Ontario thirty years ago, and worked in stained glass for 7 years and then concentrated on wood carving and printmaking. He works the gouge through the wood and following the line that gets him into zone, away from problems and into the wood and design.



His favorite woods are cherry and pear. Cherry is the traditional wood for printmakers in Japan, and pear is the traditional wood for printmakers in Europe. Both are very hard, very dense woods. With both you can carve a very fine line without worrying that the block will check or split or crack.

Robert teaches wood block printmaking in the Printmakers Studio at the Studios in the Park in Paso Robles, in case you get hooked on knowing more after the demo.

## June Meeting



On Monday June 9 at 7 o'clock in the evening Daniel D. Martin gave a demonstration of drawing to the Atascadero Art Association. He brought in a few large framed pieces to show us how drawings can look when well presented, also samples of the 8,000 prints of central coast scenes he's sold .

He set up his French easel which was actually made in France and indispensable for plein air, studio painting, and demonstrations. He started by discussing the five elements of light and shadow: 1) Highlights 2) Reflected light 3) Core shadow 4) Cast shadow 5) Half tone. His first two drawings, the portraits, were done with vine charcoal and compress charcoal - Weber Char-kole. Most of the series he did for the Bank of America were drawn with a Boral Draughting 314 pencil or under the name Sanford Design Ebony Jet Black Extra Smooth 14420. The tree scene he drew for the raffle was drawn with this pencil. He uses Conte crayon and white chalk often. He emphasized thick to thin line, and a rhythm to his "broad stroke" drawing.

We would like to thank Dan coming in on short notice to give us this fine demonstration.







Tricia Reichert was originally scheduled to demonstrate in June. However a family emergency pulled her to the east coast. The art association is fortunate and grateful that Daniel Martin was available to fill in.
