Dorothy Riggs September Demo



When Dorothy discovered that oil painting was too toxic for her, she turned to collage as an art form. She told us she has become somewhat of a “hoarder” as collage is assembled by using bits of anything you can glue on a backing. Dorothy uses foam core as a support. She is very careful to select the right kind of glue to



attach her objects. She has many bottles of glue including those that she uses for leather, plastic, cellophane .. the list is long. She may not glue on the objects immediately but moves things in different positions, taking photos as she goes. These pictures help her make final decisions. Then she glues. She used Mod Podge for her demonstration. Delicate items such as pieces of string can be attached using a gluey toothpick. Her materials were hand made



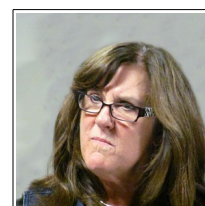
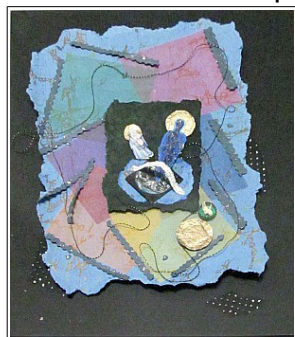
paper and also images that she cut out of her sketch book. She layers. Collage pieces can be made with magazine pages but copy right guidelines are quite ambiguous so care should be taken when using someone else's images.



Dorothy read Seena Frost's book Soulcollage and is now collaging 5 X 7 inch cards cut from mat board. Dorothy writes some interwisdom on the back, words that come from a hidden place within. These cards seem easy to do. Seena Frost has a very good video on her web site, if you are interested.

Another similar website which has a little different perspective is Postsecret. If this site needs some

explaining, try Wikipedia Postsecret. Taking a break from our chosen art form and making some of these cards might be fun!
