Art Sherwyn Demonstration April 13, 7 to 9 pm Atascadero GospelChapel
Atascadero Ave and Curbaril

Art Sherwyn's presentation for the Atascadero Art Association on Monday, April 13th is designed to transport those in attendance on a unique journey through the world of art, and its evolution. He will engage the audience with an array of perspectives in regard to art, the creation of it, and its connection with all other aspects of one's life.

At the easel, Art will be demonstrating a wide range of concepts and techniques including his theory of "line, mass, dance:" an unpretentious process for the structure of most works of art. He will share his theories on the artistic playing field, and the 4 stages of artistic development, a process for continually growing and reaching new plateaus as an artist.

This journey is not about any one medium, it's far bigger and more engaging. The mediums used in this demonstration are only a vehicle for conveying the relevance and significance of the messages in the presentation; the topics transfer to all mediums.

Art will also share some of his latest works, including his "smoke and fire" pieces; a series of works created from the smoke of a candle and the fire from a torch.

The entire presentation will prove to be upbeat and alive with unique, yet pertinent perspectives on art, life, and the process for conquering the plateaus that continually plague the learning process. Within this journey will lie the renewed motivation for creating more art.

Bonné Scott March Demo



Talented jewelry artist, **Bonné Scott**, gave us instructions on how to make an inexpensive glass pendant. She brought a good selection of glass pieces. She had shaped them with a glass cutter and smoothed their edges.



Glass scraps can be purchased at Carol's Stained Glass, Main Street, Templeton. We used a good quality jewelry glue called "diamond" glue.



We coated our pendant with glue and applied in an artful way, tiny pieces of paper, ribbon, and glitter. Bonné also supplied shiny paper cut from gift bags purchased at the Dollar Store.



Bonné uses this food dryer she found at the thrift store to dry her jewelry. When the piece is dry, another coat of glue can be brushed on and more decoration added. Pendants can be dried in a low temperature oven or left to dry overnight.



Wow! They look great. We will glue on a bail which can be purchased at Michaels. We will wear our masterpieces around our necks and wait for the compliments!
