Thursday morning Art makers

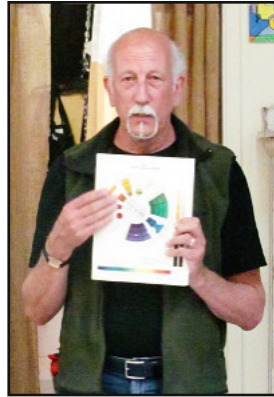

Thursday Art Brownbag

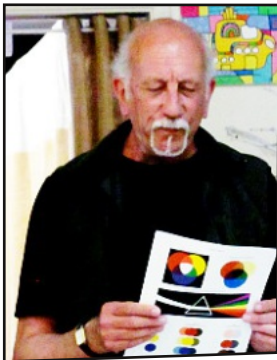

WB Eckert spoke on color mixing at our June 8th meeting

Bill suggests using a grey palette when mixing, because the background effects how you see the color you are mixing. He uses glass with gray paper sandwiched on cardboard for palette. He strongly recommends using a limited palette and continuing to use the same paints regularly so you will get to know those paint combinations well.

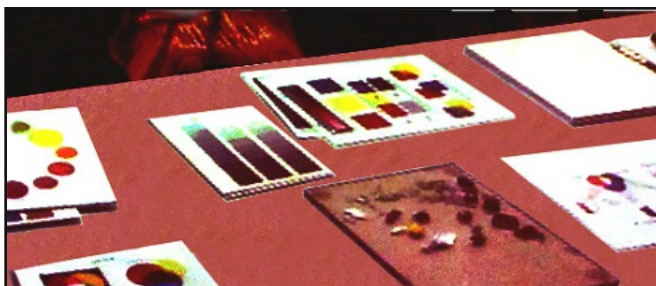


He also believes you should make your own color charts in different hues and values so that you know all the combinations. For example Ultra marine blue and burnt sienna combine to make black that does not lose its brilliance as does using tube black. He suggests putting the paint on the palette in the same position to make it easier to remember where you are working. He also suggests when mixing color, start with the light color and adding the darker color in small increments. It



is much easier to add a bit of dark than to keep adding a lot of white or light color. He also works away from the original color, so you can see what you did if you need to recreate it.
