November Demonstration

Kate Moldauer is a figurative artist who has taught many classes in human anatomy for artists. She compares drawing to construction, where you must have the framing in place before beginning on the outside. She strongly suggests having an anatomy teacher rather than trying to learn it yourself from a book.
Landmarks are the places where the bones come to the surface. For example, the body would be eight heads high. The pubic bone would then be at four heads down.
Kate referred to George Bridgeman's book where the body is depicted in cubes so that you also consider the depth of the body, and adjustments you will have to make to put depth in a three dimensional

work. All faces have the same planes and individual adjustments can be made from there.

She also suggested smart phone apps such as, "art pose" and "skelly" and a reference book, Valerie Winslow's, "Classic Human Anatomy."

Kate Moldauer is a great teacher and will be offering a class in her studio on Traffic Way soon.
